Before beginning the interview, ask the person what is the highest grade completed in school. Answer:

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## INTERVIEWER SCORING GUIDELINES*

Ask the person questions 1 through 10 in this list and record all answers. In order to be scored as correct, all responses must be given without reference to calendar, newspaper, birth certificate or other aid to memory. Refusal to answer counts as incorrect.

Question 1 Score as correct only when the exact month, exact date and the exact year are provided. If only the month and date are provided, ask "and what is the year?"

Question 2 The correct day of the week must be given.

Question 3 Score as correct if any correct description of the location is given. "My home", correct name of the town or city of residence, or the name of hospital or institution (if person is institutionalized) are all acceptable as correct answers.

Question 4 Score as correct when the correct telephone number can be verified. If the person has no phone, then and only then ask the street address question.

Question 5 Score as correct according to person's actual age on day of interview.

Question 6 Score as correct when the month, exact date and year are all provided.

Question 7 Requires only the last name of the current President.

Question 8 Requires only the last name of the previous President.

Question 9 Score as correct if a female first name is given with a last name other than person's last name.

Question 10 Read this question exactly as printed. You may repeat if necessary or offer the probe "Can you subtract 3 from 20? And 3 from that?" The person must get the entire series correct to be scored correct. Any error in the series or unwillingness to attempt the series is scored as incorrect.
*Note on Scoring: 1 more error is allowed in the scoring if the person has had a grade school education or less.

1 less error is allowed if the person has had education beyond the high school level.
